## IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

**DANGER** – Any hair dryer is electrically live even when the switch is off. To reduce the risk of death or injury by electric shock:

- Please keep the instruction manual, guarantee certificate, the sales receipt and, if possible, the carton with the inner packaging.
- Before using, check if any of the parts are loose, if so, tighten it accordingly to make sure that the structure is stable.
- Before plugging in the appliance, check that the socket and power match those of the appliance. Attention shall be paid to whether the rated value of input supply voltage is according to that of rated input value or not.
- **DO NOT IMMERSE THE HAIR DRYER INTO WATER OR ANY OTHER LIQUIDS.**
- Hair dryer should never be left unattended when plugged or in use.
- Do not pull, twist, or wrap line cord around dryer, even during storage.
- To disconnect, turn the control OFF, then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use the appliance for other than its intended use.
- This appliance should not be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they are supervised by the person who is responsible for their safety.
- Keep the hair dryer out of the reach of children. Do not leave children unsupervised with the hair dryer.
- While using the appliance, keep your hair out of it. Keep your hair away from the air inlets.
- Do not use with voltage converter.



## USING THE HAIR DRYER

### DRYER OPERATION

The left knob as you face the dryer is the **TIMER CONTROL**. Turn this knob to the drying time selected. The timer will automatically regulate the drying cycle from ten to sixty minutes.

Once the dryer is turned on, all phases of the drying cycle can transpire; the air is heated and the blower operates. The dryer can be **MANUALLY** shut off by turning the knob to the "0" position.

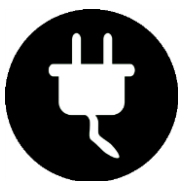
### TEMPERATURE CONTROL

The right knob of the dryer offers seven different temperature selections. These selections range from 104°-167°F.

### DRYING TIME AND TEMPERATURE

Drying times and temperatures will vary from client to client, depending upon hair texture, color, style and personal sensitivity.

**CAUTION:** Hair must be pinned down and covered due to the upward airflow.



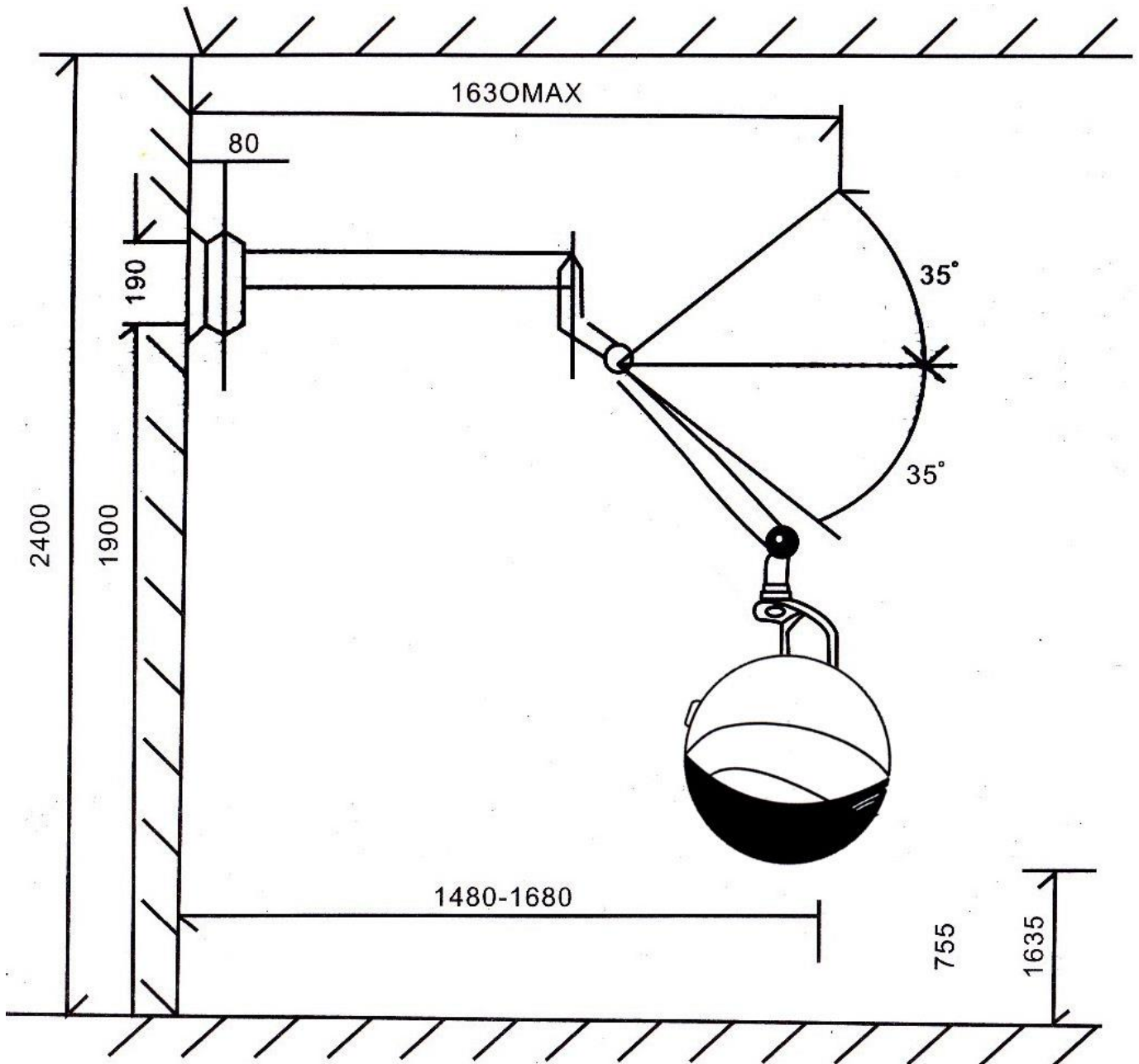

## Attaching the Wall Dryer to the Wall



- Periodically inspect the wall unit for secure mounting.
- Do not use attachments that are not recommended by the manufacturer. Any damage due to use of unsupported accessories will not be covered by warranty.
- Do not use extension cords or other accessories; otherwise, stated herewithin.
- Never operate the appliance if it has a damaged cord/plug, has been dropped, damaged, or immersed into any water surfaces.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use this dryer to dry a wig or items that are made of materials that may cause fire.
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or when oxygen was being administered.
- While using the appliance, keep hair away from the inlets to prevent irritation and burning.
- Unplug immediately after using.
- If by any chance, the hair dryer stopped working, please contact your service provider for assistance.

# HAIR DRYER PARTS



## INSTALLATION



**WARNING**

This unit is heavy, and if not properly secured during installation and assembly could fall, possibly causing injury as well as damage to property.

1. Screw off the screw.





2.

a) Pull-up the stainless steel ring.

b) Insert the short metal rod of the arm unit into the hole of the heater at an appropriate length, which means the four steel balls need to be strictly aligned with the rod's groove. If not, the stainless steel ring couldn't be pulled-down in any case.



c) Pull-down the stainless steel ring.



3. Screw on the screw to support the fixture.
